### **Middle School History** (no changes in history textbooks)

- The current 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade History- Ancient History- textbook will be reused by next year's 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade students. (same book for two years; **5<sup>th</sup> graders keep your book**)
- The current 7<sup>th</sup> grade History- US History- textbook will be reused by next year's 7<sup>th</sup> grade students.
- The current 8<sup>th</sup> grade History- World Geography- textbook will be reused by next year's 8<sup>th</sup> grade students.

### **Middle School English Language Arts** (no changes in literature textbooks)

- The current 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade Literature textbook will be reused by next year's 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade students. (same book for two years; **5<sup>th</sup> graders keep your book**)
- The current 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade Literature textbook will be reused by next year's 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students. (same book for two years; **7<sup>th</sup> graders keep your book**)

### **Middle School Science** (no change in science textbooks for the 2010-2011 school year)

- The current 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade Science textbook will be reused by next year's 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade students. (same book for two years; **5<sup>th</sup> graders keep your book**)
- The current 7<sup>th</sup> grade Science textbook will be reused by next year's 7<sup>th</sup> grade students.
- The current 8<sup>th</sup> grade Science textbook will be reused by next year's 8<sup>th</sup> grade students.

### **Middle School Math** (a few changes in math textbooks for the 2011-2012 school year)

- The current 5<sup>th</sup> grade math textbook will be reused by next year's 5<sup>th</sup> grade student (no change).
- The current 6<sup>th</sup> grade blue "Course 1" math textbook will be reused by next year's 6<sup>th</sup> grade students (no change).
- The current 7<sup>th</sup> grade green "Course 2" math textbook will be reused by next year's 7<sup>th</sup> grade students (no change).
- The current 8<sup>th</sup> grade Algebra 1 textbook will be reused next year by 8<sup>th</sup> and some 9<sup>th</sup> grade students.
